We have tennis racquets, balls and a set of golf clubs available for our guests. The use of the golf course will be subject to availability and must be booked in advance

- There is a programme of equestrian activities with the Peruvian Paso Horses, directed by our field personnel.

All our horses are high quality animals, which stems from a long selection raising and training process, and they must be used by responsible riders with a know-how.

In order to offer our guests the possibility to go through the process of becoming acquainted with this breed, we have elaborated the following Equestrian Programme for a minimum stay of three days. For shorter stays, only the activities planned for the first or second day will take place.

On the first day, the activities include a clinic which aims at showing the principles and techniques for riding a Peruvian Paso Horse. The classes are given at the paddock track and are adapted, by our field personnel, to the different levels of the rider's knowledge and experience with horses. Then, the riders can ride on the different horses ready for sale, so that they can find the one which best complements their own characteristics and personality, since it is necessary to establish a symbiosis with the horse in order to fully enjoy its characteristics.

After this first step, on the second day, our guests have the possibility to go on a horse ride along the paths which connect the Haras with neighbouring landscapes, always in small groups and with personalised attention.

On the third day, the visitors can go on a whole-day horse ride, which includes a country lunch on the way.

All these activities are subject to the Field Host's criterion and will take place as long as the general condition of the rider permits it, and our personnel consider their riding ability appropriate, in order to safeguard the physical integrity of the visitor, and not to harm the horse.

The guests who stay at our cottage for longer periods, can distribute these activities throughout their stay, coordinating them with the Field Department.

Guests can watch the daily tasks of caring and training of the horses which are available for sale, and also exchange experiences and knowledge with our experts, and even take part in those tasks which are not considered risky, subject to the approval and supervision of our field personnel.

Since rural activities must follow a daily routine, and our main one is the breeding and training of horses, all the equestrian and rural activities must be previously requested and coordinated with the Field Host.

- The price does not include TAX and is applied for a whole day, checking in from 11 am. The room checkout is at 9:30 am.
- If the guest wishes to remain until the afternoon, a rate of 50% of the daily price will be applied.
- In order to confirm a reservation, the guest or intermediary must make a 50% deposit of the total stay, on an account designated by Haras Ampascachi.

- If a guest cancels a confirmed reservation with more than 24-hour notice, the total amount deposited will remain as credit against future booking, subject to availability and valid for three months. If the cancellation is made in less than 24-hour's notice, a cancellation fee will be incurred equivalent to a one-day stay, and the difference will remain as credit against future booking, subject to availability and valid for three months.
